



Covid 19 Mitigation Plan

To further enhance our already stringent sterilization policy, we are now regularly having our entire restaurant disinfected by a professional company. They are using Bioesque, a disinfectant that kills 99.9% of Bacteria, Viruses, Fungi & Molds. It kills Norovirus in just 4 minutes.

We will continue to do everything we can to ensure the safety of our guests and our staff, including but not limited to:

Guidelines for All Phases: Employers

- We have implemented social distancing as recommended by The Governor of the State of Florida, the DBPR, and the FRLA.
- We are using single-use menus and are discarding them immediately after use
- We require every guest to wear a mask as they enter, upon leaving and any other time they are out of their seats. Guests may remove their masks while seated and dining or consuming beverages.
- We require all Delivery personnel to wear masks and practice contact free delivery
- We require every employee to have their temperature taken and recorded prior to shift by manager on duty
- We require all common surfaces that are regularly touched to be sanitized at least hourly, if not more, including, but not limited to, counter top surfaces, ALL door handles, and computer screens
- We require all table tops and booths (chairs) to be sanitized and fresh paper covering be placed on the table, before seating the next guests
- We require ALL condiments to be removed from the table and sanitized before the next use and only presented when requested
- We require all check presenters to be sanitized between each use

Guidelines for All Phases: Individuals

- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer regularly, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue, or the inside of your elbow.
- Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces as much as possible.
- Strongly recommend using face coverings while in public, especially when using mass transit
